The Pastor's Two Bits...

Welcome to Fairfield Glade First Baptist Church! Thank you for choosing to worship with us today! I hope you have a great experience with God as you offer your prayers and praise.

The Southern Baptist Convention was organized in 1845, largely because of the conflict in America leading up to the Civil War. As did the country on many other issues, Northern Baptists and Southern Baptists went their separate ways. But at the heart of the SBC from the very beginning was missions - "Foreign" and "Domestic". One of their first orders of business was to establish two boards to meet the challenge of taking the Gospel to all people everywhere. Missions were built into the 'DNA' of Southern Baptists. We've organized ourselves around missions from the beginning of our history. For almost 100 years, we have operated under the Cooperative Program in which all of our churches band together to support missions locally and around the world. Last year, nearly 50,000 SBC churches contributed almost \$450 million to the Cooperative Program. That helps support over 3,500 full-time missionaries worldwide, another 3,000 or so in North America, and a myriad of ministries and missions nearly everywhere on the planet. But that's not all.

We've also organized ourselves to be independent from and interdependent on, other churches. Every SBC church is autonomous; but we choose to affiliate with larger groups of like-minded churches. We have local associations and statewide conventions. These partners help us network effectively to do more ministry and missions than we could do on our own. We are part of the Cumberland Plateau Baptist Association and the Tennessee Baptist Convention. And every now and then, I like for us to hear from our local and state leadership. So today, we welcome Kirk Casey, our Associational Missionary from our Cumberland Plateau Baptist Association.
