During our vacation to Maine a couple of months ago, Kay Lynn and I toured some beautiful coastal areas. We saw several prominent lighthouses and enjoyed hiking along rocky cliffs above the water. One of the sights was a state park that preserved some old World War II bunkers that were built to protect our northern coast. During their heyday, they were equipped with large guns; but today they lay empty and are nothing more than tourist attractions. I found them interesting. Thick-walled concrete and steel. Most of their structure was underground, grass and trees growing on their 'roofs'. But after more than 80 years, they are still there and likely could be for hundreds more. They are firmly built on rock solid foundations.
